

Allen Jones/Marjorie Barringer/BarKays Scholarship Fund

This fund memorializes Allen A. Jones, former producer and mentor of the BarKays, a Memphis music institution. His mother, Marjorie Barringer, and BarKays members James Alexander and Larry Dodson created the fund.

Allen began his musical career by taking piano lessons from his aunt. He later mastered the bass, fiddle and piano. He played in his junior and senior high school bands. His teenage years became the backdrop for his professional entry into the music industry, where he not only wrote songs for Isaac Hayes and Otis Redding, but also managed and produced the highly successful BarKays. "At the age of 17, Allen was fortunate enough to know what he wanted to do in life. But many of today's high school seniors either don't know where they want to go, or have no one interested in helping them get there," notes Ms. Barringer. "Allen was an average student who had talent and worked hard. He was a behind-the-scenes person who knew how to share success with others," recalls Dodson. The purpose of the fund is to benefit graduating high school seniors who live in the city of Memphis and will attend LeMoyne-Owen College.

Applicants for the Allen Jones/Marjorie Barringer/BarKays Scholarship Fund must:

- ◆ be graduating high school seniors from Memphis City Schools or previous recipients attending LeMoyne-Owen College. This fund will provide support for students for up to two years.
- ◆ demonstrate economic need
- ◆ have a C average or better
- ◆ have been accepted by and will attend LeMoyne-Owen College
- ◆ provide school records reflecting good conduct and attendance
- ◆ submit the application form and the required attachments.

A complete application includes:

- ◆ completed application form
- ◆ two current letters of recommendation from teachers, clergy or persons other than family members who are familiar with your skills and abilities
- ◆ most recent high school or college transcript
- ◆ copy of your ACT and/or SAT scores
- ◆ copy of your Student Aid Report (SAR) and Expected Family Contribution (EFC) information, which you will receive when you complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

Your application and all related attachments must be received in the offices of the Community Foundation of Greater Memphis by 5 p.m. on April 2, 2012.
