

## Kylen C. Bares Memorial Scholarship Fund

This fund memorializes Kylen C. Bares, son of Madge and Steven Bares. Kylen was involved in a fatal car accident on June 27, 2007. All throughout his 22 years, Kylen held an exquisite curiosity for life. As a child, he was driven to understand the way machines worked. He could be found tinkering with Legos or taking apart household gadgets. As a teenager, he tried to understand ideas: where they came from and why they were important. Finally as an adult, Kylen sought to understand the human condition. Kylen graduated in May, 2007 from Vanderbilt University with a degree in Biomedical Engineering and was preparing to enter medical school in 2008. The family cherishes the memory of this happy, proud, strong, confident, creative, independent, inventive and generous person.

The fund has been established to assist at least one student annually from the Memphis Academy of Science and Engineering and/or a Memphis City High School. This includes charter schools, contract schools and public high schools within Memphis, Tennessee.

Applicants for the Kylen C. Bares Memorial Scholarship Fund must:

- ◆ be a senior at the Memphis Academy of Science and Engineering or be a senior at a charter school or public city school in Memphis, Tennessee
- ◆ plan to major in Math, Science or Engineering
- ◆ have a minimum 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- ◆ participate in extracurricular high school activities
- ◆ be accepted and plan to attend a college in the United States as a full-time student
- ◆ submit the application form and the required attachments

A complete application includes:

- ◆ completed application form
- ◆ typed essay telling about your life goals, specifically detailing their reasons for majoring in Math, Science or Engineering in college and plans post graduation. **Requirements:** At least one page in length, single-spaced in 12 pt. type with 1 inch margins
- ◆ two current letters of recommendation from high school counselors and/or teachers attesting to good conduct and character and demonstrated interests in math, science or engineering
- ◆ most recent high school or college transcript
- ◆ copy of your ACT and/or SAT scores
- ◆ copy of your Student Aid Report (SAR) and Expected Family Contribution (EFC) information, which you will receive when you complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

Your application and all related attachments must be received in the offices of the Community Foundation of Greater Memphis by 5 p.m. on April 2, 2012.
