

Mildred Galloway Scholarship Fund

Mildred Galloway's teaching career began in Strawberry, AR in a one room school in 1946. She also served as a home demonstration agent in Jonesboro, AR, followed by dietitian positions at Baptist Memorial Hospital in Little Rock and Memphis from 1951 to 1953. She began teaching elementary school in Memphis, TN in 1953, then accepted a position to teach at Ramstein Air Force Base and lived in Germany until 1957. Upon returning to the United States she returned to teaching in Memphis City Schools, where she taught at Sherwood Junior High School, Overton High School, and Craigmont High School. In 1972, she was selected as Tennessee's Teacher of the Year for her teaching efforts and positive impact on Tennessee's youth. During her 35 year teaching career Mildred taught every grade except third, and was widely known for teaching food services and running the Tea Room at Craigmont High School. After retiring from the Memphis City Schools, Mildred opened *Miss Muff'n*, a bakery, in Germantown, TN and became known as one of the premier wedding cake designers in the Mid South. This scholarship is offered in her honor for a student from Memphis City Schools whose high school study is in the area of Family and Consumer Sciences.

Applicants for the Mildred Galloway Scholarship Fund must:

- be a senior graduating from a Memphis City School
- have been successfully enrolled in any Family and Consumer Sciences class during the 2011-2012 school year
- have a minimum of a 3.0 cumulative grade point average (GPA) out of a 4.0 point system
- be accepted and plan to attend an accredited vocational school, technical school, or two year or four-year accredited college or university
- submit the application form and the required attachments by April 2, 2012

A complete application includes:

- ◆ completed application form
- ◆ Two **current** letters of recommendation ó one (1) from persons other than family members who are familiar with you and one (1) letter of recommendation from teacher, employer or person other than family members who has knowledge of the your related skills in either Family and Consumer Sciences.
- ◆ most recent high school or college transcript
- ◆ copy of your ACT and/or SAT scores
- ◆ copy of your Student Aid Report (SAR) and Expected Family Contribution (EFC) information, which you will receive when you complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

Your application and all related attachments must be received in the offices of the Community Foundation of Greater Memphis by 5 p.m. on April 2, 2012.

Typically this scholarship is awarded to one student each year.
