Washington High School and/or Metropolitan Baptist Church in Memphis, Tennessee. This fund will assist applicants in achieving life long educational goals. This is a memorial scholarship fund in honor of Harold & Ida Jamison, who graduated from Booker T. Washington and were members of Metropolitan Baptist Church.

The award(s) are presented to applicants displaying academic excellence, leadership, community service and financial need. This is a one-time scholarship.

In order to apply for the Harold & Ida Jamison Scholarship Fund you must:

- ◆ must be a U.S. citizen
- ◆ must be a high school graduating senior from Booker T Washington High School or Metropolitan Baptist Church, Memphis, Tennessee
- ◆ a minimum of a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 point system
- ◆ demonstrate financial need as by FAFSA guidelines

A complete application includes:

- ◆ completed application form
- ◆ two current letters of recommendations from either teachers, counselors, clergy or a persons other than family members who are familiar with your skills and abilities
- ◆ most recent high school transcript
- ◆ copy of your ACT and/or SAT scores
- ◆ copy of letter verifying acceptance to an accredited four-year not-for-profit college or university as a full-time student
- ◆ copy of applicant's student aid report (SAR) and expected Family Contribution (FFC) information, which will be received when the Free Application for Federal Student AID (FFSA) is completed.

Your application and all related attachments must be received in the offices of the Community Foundation of Greater Memphis by 5 p.m. on April 2, 2012.
